- **Respite gives caregivers a break, which allows them to have time for themselves. This may help decrease stress put on families while caring for loved one.**

- Home Care
- Adult Day Care
- Campership Program
- A short stay in a facility
- Caregiver Directed Option, which you can pay for services or items that make caregiving easier, and be reimbursed.
